Attachment 2: <u>DRAFT/SAMPLE:</u> Proposed Loan from UUFBR Endowment Fund to the UUFBR Fellowship

The Bylaws covering the Endowment Fund specifically states that the Endowment Committee may make Loans of the capital funds to Unitarian Universalist Congregations, even if such loans decrease the return on investment which would otherwise be earned. Loans may not exceed 2/3rds of the Endowment's value as of the close of the prior fiscal year. The measure of the amount of funds available as of Dec. 30, 2020, is \$158,000.00. The Endowment Committee clearly has the wherewithal to provide a loan to the Fellowship to support the need of funds in synchrony with the Capital Fund Drive now being considered. This has been a standard practice in support of Capital Needs since the establishment of the Endowment Fund in 1986.

Here is a proposed Loan for the Congregation's consideration.

- 1. Loan Amount: \$75,000.00
- 2. Terms and Conditions:
 - a. This Loan will be paired with the existing UUFBR Loan settled in 2014 which went into effect on July 1st, 2014. This was established as a 50 Year Loan.
 - b. The new Loan for \$75K will be given at the time of agreement between Endowment Committee and Board of Trustees officers following approval of the Congregation.
 - c. Payment of the new Loan in conjunction with the existing Loan will begin on July 1st, 2022.

There will be a balance of 42 years left on the paired Loans.

The existing Loan has a monthly payment of \$1039.13. The new Loan of \$75K will have an incremental payment of \$216.11. The sum payment, therefore, as of July 1st, 2022, will be \$1255.24. This is in fact a modest sum of money for the Congregation to be paying for such a pleasant campus and attractive buildings.

d. The interest rate on the Loans and penalties for late payment will be administered per the existing conditions and terms of the current year 2014 agreement.

In conclusion, we think this is a practical and viable solution to fulfill the Congregation's need for the Capital Funds required to bring our facility up to current standards. As mentioned previously, this has been a common practice here at the Fellowship over the years. It is meaningful for us now to recognize the wisdom of the founders of our Endowment Fun. Today, we should honor their generosity for the hundreds of thousands of dollars they donated to the Fund from its inception in 1986 through the last \$15K bequest received from the Wilma Chapin Estate in 2012.
