

Election Expo 2024, the first of its kind event in Palm Beach County, will be held on Monday, **September 30, 2024. from 5:30-7:30pm** at Palm Beach State College (Lake Worth Campus) Gymnasium.

Organizers of this nonpartisan event have invited the candidates for every local and state office to attend and the League expects almost 100% response. Each candidate will be at their own table and available to speak to residents about why they deserve your vote.

There will also be tables staffed by League volunteers to help people register to vote, check their voter status, and apply to receive a vote-by-mail ballot. Leaguers from the Speakers Bureau will be staffing tables to explain the Constitutional Amendments that will be on the ballot.

The Supervisor of Elections of Palm Beach County will have staff present with a voting machine so people can practice and be comfortable with the process.

And there will be cafés serving free ice cream, specialty coffees, and popcorn. Free prizes will be awarded. Attendees will also be able to view the Palm Beach County League's premier showing of "Why Vote", a video of interviews with people throughout Palm Beach county who answer the question, "why vote?"

The group met its initial objective of having healing conversations as well as reinvigorating or starting some core teams including the Program Planning Council, the Care Team and the Stewardship Team. We had lots of engagement, with lively conversation and exchange of ideas. Many thanks to all who gave up some Saturday afternoons to strengthen and serve the congregation.

The larger group divided into areas of interest, and a lot of progress was made:

A Care Team was established. The Care Team will be a bridge for referrals from the congregation to requested care services, supportive outreach, and/or to services in the community, until an appropriately available minister is hired and on board. The role of the Care Team will be reassessed at that time. Team members will provide brief listening/ companioning, care cards, emails, texts, and/or calls of outreach to those with concerns, and give referral information for accessing community services as requested.

With the approval of the Board of Trustees, several new members were added to the Minister Search Team. With more resources, the Team was able to broaden the search parameters and identify new potential candidates. This Team is working so hard, it's difficult to take a snapshot in time that will be relevant in two weeks. You'll being hearing more from them in the near future. Robert Duchemin and Sandy Troiano are co-leading this group.

A Program Planning Council was established, bringing to fruition many months of guided effort by Rev. Kathy. This group will oversee UUFBR activities in the bigger picture. The Program Planning Council will provide high-level coordination of programs, committees, and events to help ensure good communication and smooth outcomes. This exciting new group will be led by Jacquie Velazquez and Courtney Cannon.

The Worship Team got some welcome new members. As we enter a time when our lay leadership will play an increasingly prominent role in worship, the work of this team will become even more important. We are fortunate to have a vital, thriving Worship Team here at UUFBR. Contact them if you'd like to participate, have ideas for a service, or just to say "Job well done!" The points of contact for the Worship Team are Ron Roth and Allison Rognas.

A Stewardship Team was formed. Under the able leadership of Treasurer Bill Jensen, this group will oversee the larger picture of giving and gifting at UUFBR. Nancy Hutter and Linda Prentice are the points of contact for this team.

The United in Spirit Team was established to provide a forum for us to continue the healing conversation begun at these meetings, centering around topics such as our relationship to the UUA, what the Article II changes mean for us, and other denominational issues. The contact person for this group is Jennifer Ligeti.


